500 points for a letter

Points do not accumulate from year to year

Membership

Band Membership	100pts
Parades/Football games	25pts
Loading/unloading equipment	5-10pts
Providing truck	10pts
Basketball games	15pts
Jazz Band	75pts

All band members are required to attend every parade, home football game, concert and graduation. Basketball games are voluntary if attendance/instrumentation is acceptable. It is imperative to look and sound our best at all outdoors community-attended events.

To earn full points at games and events you must be ready to play on time.

Lack of appropriate dress for performance	-50 points
Inappropriate behavior-anywhere, anytime	Loss of letter and all traveling privileges

Miscellaneous

Students will conduct themselves in a courteous, decent and respectful manner at all times when representing the band. Disrespect toward anyone, argumentative, loud, obnoxious or offensive behavior while representing the band will result in loss of letter and loss of trips, and/or school disciplinary action.

Awards

Honorary Awards

McKinley Inspirational Award: class vote

The senior who most inspires others through their musical excellence and dedication.

Mathew Wellman Inspirational Award: class vote

The 10th, 11th or 12th grade student who most inspires others through their musical excellence and dedication.

Haddock Service Award: director chosen

The 9th, 10th, 11th or 12th grade student who helps the director through service and dedication

The Food Service Award: director chosen

The student who goes above and beyond what is asked in terms of helping and attending events and does so with a good attitude.
