

BAND CLASS RULES

MR. DICKINSON

1. BE IN YOUR SEAT with instrument, sticks, percussion inst., music stand and music out; Jazz – 7:00 cell phone time, 1st period @ tardy bell, 2nd - 4 minutes after the bell, 4th – 4 minutes after the tardy bell) WHEN THE BELL RINGS OR YOU WILL BE COUNTED TARDY.
2. NO FOOD, NO CANDY, NO BEVERAGE (water okay) OR GUM DURING CLASS TIME
3. SHOW RESPECT TO OTHERS AND THEIR PROPERTY; keep your hands and feet to yourself; Treat others as you want to be treated.
4. SPEAK ONLY AT AN APPROPRIATE TIME; (When it pertains to all and will help the class. Personal questions need to wait until after the rehearsal, for the good of all in class. Arguing, negative comments, visiting with your neighbors wastes everybody's time, and will result in detention.
5. TAKE EXCELLENT CARE OF YOUR MUSIC, ALL INSTRUMENTS, THE ROOM AND CONTENTS ESPECIALLY IF THE DISTRICT HAS LOANED IT AND MAINTAINED IT FOR YOU.
6. DO NOT ASK TO USE THE RESTROOM OR TO LEAVE THE ROOM.
Use your break times for that.

CONSEQUENCES

1. STUDENT - TEACHER CONFERENCE, LOWERING OF DAILY GRADE
2. LUNCH DETENTION, PARENT CONTACT
3. IN-SCHOOL DETENTION
4. PERMANENT REMOVAL FROM CLASS WITH AN "F" FOR THE SEMESTER
5. IF SITUATION IS DEEMED SERIOUS ENOUGH, STUDENT MAY BE REMOVED IMMEDIATELY AND PERMANENTLY
6. **ALL SCHOOL RULES AND CONSEQUENCES APPLY TO EXTRA-CURRICULAR EVENTS WHEN YOU ARE REPRESENTING THE SCHOOL.** (Pep band, marching band, jazz band, fund-raising, band trips etc.)

Tardy Policy:

After 2 tardies in band (3 in jazz band) per quarter, the student will be assigned 1 lunch detention. Upon 3 and 4 tardies in band and jazz band respectively, the student will be given 2-3 days lunch detention. If any more tardies occur, the student will be referred to the office for further disciplinary action.
